Together we will achieve this as guided by our SHERPA Principles:



Education institutions face the highest percentage of cyber-attacks (73%) compared to any other sector.



Because you believe (88% of Headteachers and 84% of teachers) that technology had or would contribute to improved pupil attainment.



Approximately 35% of the energy consumed by devices in schools happens when no pupils are on-site.



81% of teachers believe workload contributes to high-stress levels in schools.



88% of Headteachers believe that lacking skills and confidence in technology are a barrier to uptake and its use in the classroom.



In the next 10 years, 65% of today's students will work in jobs that do not currently exist, so we need to reduce the digital divide and ensure no child gets left behind in the modern world.
